Living In The New Normal: Supporting Children Through Trauma and Loss (LINN)™

Purpose:

The purpose of Living In the New Normal™ is to provide community professionals, educators, family members, and other concerned adults with information to help the support of military children during times of uncertainty, trauma, and grief. LINN's™ efforts are predicated on the belief that children are courageous and resilient and that these skills can be strengthened through deliberate encouragement by the adults in their lives.

Terminal Learning Outcomes:

1. Acquire a basic knowledge of how military/combat-related injuries, illness, or death of a parent affects the child.
2. Identify methods of building resilience and encouraging the courage of children.
3. Identify community resources that are currently in place to support children through trauma and loss.
4. Create a customized training module for participant's various community sectors. (i.e. education, military, health, faith, business, etc.) using the information gleaned from the LINN™ Institute.

12 full seat hours required for institute credit – attendance both full days required – no partial attendance accepted. For CEU credit, participants are required to attend 95% of the training institute and fill out an end of course evaluation.

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
