

## Patricia Bradley Ewen, DoDEA

Patricia Ewen is the Education Policy Advisor for the Partnership and Resources Division within the Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA). In this role, Patty is responsible for supporting the partnership and outreach efforts of DoDEA through collaboration with national partners and advocacy groups, state education agencies and the Compact Commission. She contributes content, training and research to support the mission of responsiveness and smooth transitions for military connected students by applying practical awareness and technical knowledge of the laws, policies, regulations and guidance for K-12 education nationwide; assessing impact of policy changes and providing consideration for alternate pathways and solutions.
