Focus Groups

Give us your opinion, help test training games; read and review training materials; formulate the feedback

Professional

Lend your expertise; write an article, be a guest speaker; serve in advisory capacity; recommend resources; add MCEC to your resource list

Student

Join the Student 2 Student team; update information from your schools to SchoolQuest; earn community service hours; experience Service Learning

Support

Technical support (may require some travel); assist the training team; drive volunteers to assignments; chaperone children and teens
